

SHOW RULES

AQHA Class procedures apply to all applicable classes.

1. No refunds for scratches unless made IN OFFICE prior to the beginning of the class.
2. Must show proof of negative coggins (current).
3. Exhibitor may show one horse in multiple divisions; however, exhibitor may win only one SHOW HIGH POINT AWARD (day of show) and one SHOW RESERVE HIGH POINT (day of show).
4. Stallions may NOT be shown/exhibited by a youth in any classes. Stallions may NOT be shown period by youth. Anyone with a stallion that displays potentially dangerous behavior will be immediately excused from the arena and premises by management and/or judges. Refunds given will be at the discretion of show management.
5. Upon judge's discretion, management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes of fewer than 3 exhibitors.
6. Management reserves the right upon the judges' and/or show host discretion to split or run heats with classes of over 20 entries.
7. Any exhibitor under age 18 must wear an approved SM helmet.
8. Every exhibitor must sign a release, show current neg coggins, and be paid prior to entering the arena for clinic, show or practice. Youth must have guardian or parent's signature.

9. Management along with judges' discretion reserves the right to excuse a horse from competition if it is deemed lame or in poor health.
10. Show attire is preferred unless otherwise specified by management prior to show. I.E., 100 degrees in Texas in summer may be a T-shirt show.
11. Every exhibitor must have a number on the back of shirt or on the left side of saddle blanket when in competition.
12. Training tack is not allowed. I.e., tie downs, martingales, mechanical hackamores, etc.
13. If your horse kicks, tie a red ribbon in her/his tail.
14. Protests may be in writing, accompanied by \$50 cash or cashiers' check, immediately after the class to the show management. Judges decisions are final!!!
